Well, that's what some of you call your WCRC Board members, so we're looking for a few new crazies to join us.

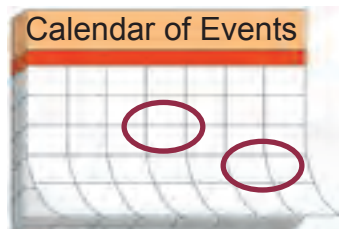
