





Hope – Theme for 9th Annual Ace It! Tournament

"Tennis is a game of hope," our pro said at the end of the doubles clinic last week. "Hope, because when your team is down, you can always change your strategy and hope for a better result against your opponents."

Yes, tennis is a game of hope. For eight years the Ace It! tournament at Orindawoods each June continues to hope for a cure for breast cancer, while raising money to help those fighting the disease. Over a hundred thousand dollars has been contributed by local tennis players and pros willing to give their time and money for this cause, hoping for a cure for our fellow tennis players and others fighting the disease.

Initially the money raised was given to the Susan G. Komen Foundation for research, then to Alta Bates Foundation for the building fund for the Carol Ann Read Breast Health Center. Now that the Center is open and providing centralized services for East Bay breast cancer patients, the money from Ace It! has been earmarked for women who cannot afford the cost of early detection and treatment at the Center.

The ninth Ace It! "Play for the Cure" tennis event and tournament is scheduled for Saturday, June 25th, 2011. The Ace It! day begins with a series of morning clinics taught by pros from several Lamorinda clubs – a great way to "demo" a pro before signing up for a series of lessons! There is always a buffet lunch with wonderful salads, sandwiches and very special desserts created just for Ace It! by a generous and talented pastry chef/tennis player. A drawing for donated prizes is held after lunch, just before the afternoon tournament begins. Players then adjourn to several other hosting Lamorinda tennis clubs for competitive tournament flights, returning to Orindawoods for the finals in each flight, or just to watch and sip "Ace It! Ale" specially brewed for the event by another generous tennis player who has perfected this now-famous beer served only one day each year.




