## New League Player Recognition Award

USTA Northern California congratulates and thanks all league players for their participation, dedication, and the many hours spent with us on the court.

Players reaching the 300, 400, 500, 600, or 700 league matches played will be recognized and awarded our Player Recognition Award Bag Tag for sustained participation in our Adult League Program!

The eleven league players, nine women and 2 men, who have exceeded the 600 and 700 levels as of July 25th, were invited to accept their award in person at last night's USTA Northern California Board of Directors meeting. Dale Russell, Adult League Committee Chair, Anna Elefant, Manager of Adult Leagues and Michael Cooke, Board President personally thanked those players in attendance.

How does one play so many matches? It starts with a healthy addiction to tennis! Nine of the 11 players who have exceeded the 600 match milestone, have been hooked on league tennis dating back to 1998 when records were first electronically archived. Good health and physical condition have kept these players on the court year after year.

And when it comes to a full menu of USTA League options, age has it's rewards. Senior players who have reached age 65 qualify to play in nine different leagues throughout the year. Greta Rzepski of Mountain View is at the top of the list with 758 matches played as of today. Randy Chen-Tse of Alamo, recently topped 700 matches and she estimates her actual number of matches played to be much higher as she began her USTA league play more than 10 years before electronic tracking began.

Randy has played both Adult and Mixed 18, 40 and 55 & Over plus the Combo League. The leagues based on combined rating levels also provide the opportunity to join teams at multiple levels; Randy with her 4.5 rating is currently playing on 8.0 and 9.0 level Adult 55 and Over teams.

Living and playing in the Bay Area affords the opportunity to join multiple teams for any league since league areas like Diablo North and Diablo South or Mid-Peninsula and Lower Peninsula are in such close proximity. Shari Kakiuchi now lives in Pleasanton but still plays on teams from Lafayette to ClubSport Fremont and over to the Peninsula.

**4** All of the players recognized tonight for having played over 600 or 700 matches live in the East Bay or

on the Peninsula. Janet Gee of El Sobrante has tennis friends all over the Bay Area from the teams she's been invited to join. Her husband, Victor, is also a league player so there's an implied understanding when most most of her weekends are full with multiple matches.

It also helps to be good! The strongest players on the team often find themselves in the line-up each week. They're often members of teams that play deep into the season, competing at Districts, Sectionals and most have played at a USTA League National Championships. Benjamin Chui of Saratoga, played 14 matches for his 8.0 Senior 60 team last year. He is currently the male with the highest number of matches played at 616.

33 players have played over 500 matches, 156 players have played over 400 matches and 672 players have played over 300 matches, all will receive their bag tag by mail along with a letter of appreciation during the month of September. The League Player Recognition awards will be presented each year. If you're curious to know how many matches you've played or how many teams/ leagues you've joined since 1998, look at the upper right corner of your player page at your own "Trophy Shelf".

**League Information:** Players may enter the WCRC Mixed Doubles League in more than one division (i.e, 6.0 and 7.0), as long as he/she is not playing below his/her level. If a player is entering in more than one division, he/she may enter with the same partner or a different partner but may not enter with different partners at the same level.

Once League play is complete and registration for the end-of-League Tournament begins, a player may **NOT** enter the Tournament at more than one level. **No exceptions!**

NTRP LEVELS	Mixed 6.0-9.0
SCHEDULING	This is an open schedule. Players are responsible for scheduling their own matches. Players will be provided with a contact list of participants within their division.
MATCH FORMAT	Best two-out-of-three set format, 12-point tiebreaker (regular scoring). No SUPERTIEBREAKERS! Both teams responsible for bringing balls to match; winning team gets unopened can. Matches should be played according to the "Rules of Tennis.".
TOURNAMENT	End of season tournament with draw determined by league standings to be held over the weekend of Jan 17–19, 2014 dependent upon court scheduling and weather. To qualify for the tournament, teams must have completed and reported at least 4 matches during the regular league season. Depending on the number of entrants
	tournament play may include Friday night play. In addition, draws with large numbers of players may be required to play matches prior to the tournament weekend. Seeding for the tournament will be based on regular season standings. The more matches you and your partner play, the higher your ranking will be.
