League Information: Players may enter the WCRC Mixed Doubles League in more than one division (i.e, 6.0 and 7.0), as long as he/she is not playing below his/her level. If a player is entering in more than one division, he/she may enter with the same partner or a different partner but may not enter with different partners at the same level.

Once League play is complete and registration for the end-of-League Tournament begins, a player may **NOT** enter the Tournament at more than one level. **The only exception will be made when the draw for a particular division is small enough to accommodate!**

MATCH FORMAT

Best two-out-of-three set format, 12-point tiebreaker (regular

scoring). No SUPERTIEBREAKERS! Both teams responsible for bringing balls to match; winning team gets unopened can. Matches should be played according to the "Rules of Tennis."

TOURNAMENT End of season tournament with draw determined by league standings

to be held over the weekend of Feb 10-12, 2017 dependent upon court scheduling and weather. To qualify for the tournament, teams must have completed and reported at least 6 matches during the regular league season. Depending on the number of entrants tournament play may include Friday night play. In addition, draws with large numbers of players may be required to play matches prior to the tournament weekend. Seeding for the tournament will be based on regular season standings of the top 4 teams in each division.

The more matches you and your partner play, the higher your ranking will be.

A minimum of 4 teams are required to generate a draw.



Their 12 courts are being resurfaced, they look amazing! Three show courts will have bleachers and chairs set up court-side so we can watch top players from around the world compete for ATP pro points in order to go up in ranking and to stake their claim of the prize money. This is the highest level ATP Challenger Event and one of six such tournaments in the US.

The college feels like the most perfect venue of all: it is neutral ground, it is central to everyone that I am reaching out to and we are involving students and staff to participate in this event. The photography department will be training and assigning tournament photographers, the broadcasting students will be shadowing and participating with the Live Streaming crew. The athletic department is allowing us to occupy space in their facility for nine days, rolling out the carpet to players, officials, volunteers and fans alike. The campus clubs will be selling concessions, the tennis team is volunteering for some of the ball kid positions, the college president, department heads, deans, professors and staff from every department is putting their best foot forward to make this event feel what it should feel like... A professional athletic tournament.

On top of all this, the proceeds will benefit the nonprofit organization: Chris Cammisa Tennis and Education Fund to keep Tennis alive at the college and in the area.
