



A keg of beer was

We had more than 85 donors and participants and 48 players entered the tennis tournament. Carlo and Lori Guariento won the tennis tournament and 4 seat tickets to a SF Giants game. Each of the flight winners also received acrystal trophy award for their accomplishments; they were Natalie Dahling and Tony Belbis; Lisa Warren and David Pintado; Michelle Muller and James Deak The winners of the "Longest Volley" were Michelle Muller and James Deak and received free passes to the ball machine at Heather Farms Tennis Center.

Douglas Fish won the grand prize for one week at The Tahoe Ridge Resort. He raised more than \$1,260 and was the leading fund raiser of all the registered entrants. Second place goes to Euna Roh with \$1,140. Honorable mention goes to Cy Lucas \$515; and Bob and Moe Satcher \$350. They each win a 2 night stay at The Smith Cabin at Lake Tahoe.
