Rules – Can I call a hindrance if my opponent's hat blows off?

ITF Rule 26 - Yes, the point shall be replayed if a player is hindered in playing the point by either an unintentional act of the opponent(s), or something outside the player's own control (not including a permanent fixture).

However, nothing a player does entitles that player to call a let. For example, a player is not entitled to a let because the player breaks a string, the player's hat falls off, or a ball in the player's pocket falls out.

Just need to know if it was the wind or player caused, and if it was even a hindrance. This actually happened in U.S. Open in 2012 between Murray and Berdych. Read more (than you thought possible) about hat hindrance. http://tennisfixation.com/tennis-rule-hathindrance.html



If a player is entering in more than one division, he/she may enter with the same partner or a different partner but may not enter with different partners at the same level.

Once League play is complete and registration for the end-of-League Tournament begins, a player may **NOT** enter the Tournament at more than one level. **The only exception will be made when the draw for a particular division is small enough to accomodate!**
