As a courtesy to other players, please call the office to release any court reservations that you will not be using.

#### **Safety Reminders**

Given the current situation, we would like to remind our patrons of the following safety guideline in order to keep the tennis center available to the public:

- Please observe appropriate physical distancing, and stay 6+ feet apart at all times. Gatherings on or around the courts are not permitted at this time.
- No handshakes, high fives, or close physical contact with members outside your household. It is recommended that each player touches only their own set of tennis balls.
- Please bring extra water and a folding chair as the water fountains, benches, and bleachers remain unavailable at this time. All gates will remain open to minimize touch points.
- Our pro-shop is not currently accepting cash as a form of payment. We accept all major credit cards, or ApplePay / Android Pay. Payment is expected prior to court usage.
- Tennis doubles is allowed with a maximum of 4 people on court. Pickleball remains singles only at this time with a maximum of 2 people on court.
- Ball Machine service, demo service, and Adult group lessons remain unavailable at this time.

## Isabella Feinberg


# She's a Bella... Isabella Feinberg

ven if she wasn't the General Manager of Lifetime Activities at Heather Farm, Isabella Feinberg would certainly be well-known on the courts. Her distinctive smile welcomes people as they come to Heather and her big serve and tough groundies have been hurting people since 2015 when she began playing tennis here.

Backing up, Isabella was born in Chicago but moved with her mom to Manila when she was just two and a half. (That's in the Philippines, not the little town in Utah.) Six or so years later, Isabella welcomed her sister into their family. Manila was a great place to grow up with lots of extended family, activities at the country club and good schooling. At the age of four Isabella started tennis lessons along with tap, ballet, hula, swimming to name just a few of her activities. Both Isabella and her Mom liked the tennis clothes the best, so her career was off and running. She didn't play competitively though until arriving in the Bay Area.



After college in Manila, Isabella decided to move to the U.S. because Mom and Dad agreed that getting a Masters degree here was a good idea. So with tears of joy, she left the Philippines heading for the Bay Area. She chose the Bay Area for many reasons and because of an Uncle living here. But once here she found that most grad programs wanted her to have two years of work experience before starting business school. That little hiccup started her career in Recreation when in July 2014 she got a job with Lifetime Tennis as the office manager. After a few months in Walnut Creek, she was drafted into Lifetime's corporate office, until January 2017 when she took the GM position at Heather.

Isabella's parents weren't about to let their little girl slip away so easily and before COVID they were visiting four times a year. Plus, there's a daily phone call. Isabella's Mom loves to shop and would take Isabella's car, promising to pick her up after work. During their Spring of 2015 visit, Mom just couldn't be torn away from Target to pick Isabella up from work but that was Elliot Feinberg's good luck. He'd hang around, keeping her company, then jokingly offered to give her a ride home if she'd go out to dinner him. The rest was history.


Isabella has had many exciting changes in her life in the past year or so. First, her Mom gave birth to twin boys in March 2019 at the age of 50. Now she has brothers just over a year old.
