#### Was it Disney Magic or the Manhattans That Kept Them Coming Back?


As an effort to get to know our membership the Board has decided to start a new monthly column "Member Spotlight". We will be interviewing WCRC members and getting to know them. This article will help us find out how they got introduced to tennis, their background, any favorite memories, etc. We hope you enjoy this new commentary.

usan was born and raised in Walnut Creek. She is the youngest of 6 children, but was likely the most active. Susan began figure skating lessons at the Sun Valley ice rink when she was 7. As her skating skills improved, she moved to the larger Berkeley Iceland rink and was on her way to becoming a competitive figure skater. Her days were filled with figure skating and then more figure skating.

Susan's days would begin at 3:30 in the morning and she would be on the ice from 5am to 10am. She would then change clothes in the car and



attend school until early afternoon. Then back to the ice rink after changing clothes in the car for another 3-4 hours. Susan would then go to her ballet lesson from 5:30pm



to 7pm (and, yes, changing clothes in the car again). I'm sure she ate at some point, probably in the car!

During her high school years Susan had a tutor, which allowed her to practice skating 6-7 hours a day. Her coach also instructed a young, up-and-coming skater and friend of Susan's named Kristi Yamaguchi. Susan would commute down to San Mateo to train. She had other coaches and

choreographers and her mother was kept busy sewing sequins on her costumes. Susan competed in the Central Pacific Regional Championships and Pacific Coast Sectional Championships and was an alternate for the US National Team in 1985 (very impressive Susan).

Susan grew up skating with many of the top Bay Area figure skaters – Kristi Yamaguchi, Brian Boitano, Debi Thomas and Yvonne Gomez. She also competed against the infamous Tonya Harding. She has remained friends with Brian Boitano and Yvonne Gomez and skates once a year at their annual charity event in San Francisco. Susan ended her skating career after high school.



Susan attended DVC where she met her future husband, John. She would graduate from San Diego State University and then receive her teaching credential from Cal State Hayward. Susan began teaching 1<sup>st</sup> grade at Sacred Heart In Oakland where she was to stay for 5 years.

Susan and John were married in 1992. They have 3 children and have been married for 28 years. She took a break from teaching while raising her children. The family joined Oakhurst CC and the children started taking tennis lessons. Susan soon joined in on the fun and began taking clinics and lessons herself. The tennis bug had hit her! She would take her daughter to ballet lessons in Walnut Creek



and having time on her hands began playing tennis at Heather Farm.

Her husband, John, also began to play tennis and they both started playing on teams out of Heather. Susan has played on many teams and soon began to co-captain teams as well. Susan was on a mixed 7.0 team that made



Nationals in 2018. Unfortunately, having just gone back to work teaching, she was unable to play at Nationals in Florida. For the last 3 years, Susan has worked for the Mt. Diablo Unified School District at El Monte Elementary, teaching 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade.

Susan and John's other great love is Disneyland and Disney's California Adventure. They go to the park every 6 weeks or so although this past year

has obviously been the exception. With the parks reopening soon, rest assured, they already have several trips planned. Susan's favorite ride is Guardians of the Galaxy – Mission: BREAKOUT, which is located in the California Adventure Park. Another of her favorites is Pirates of the Caribbean (mine too). They enjoy everything from the parades and shows, to the Animation Academy and the dining. Susan and John also love to be ambassadors for the park to their friends and people they meet at the parks.
