Spotlight

A high flyer both on and off the tennis court

Interview and article by Glenn McBee.

As an effort to get to know our membership the Board has decided to start a new monthly column "Member Spotlight". We will be interviewing WCRC members and getting to know them. This article will help us find out how they got introduced to tennis, their background, any favorite memories, etc. We hope you enjoy this new commentary.

aul was born in San Francisco and raised in the East Bay. He is the middle son of three boys. His family settled in south Orinda when there were orchards to roam and it was "OK' to shoot their guns just outside of their house. It was also a time when the 49ers held training camp and St. Mary's college. Paul went and watched training camp one day and called out to player and future NFL hall of famer Leo Nomellini, who smiled with a toothless grin and waved.

Paul first fell in love with tennis while attending Miramonte High School where he also played football. He attended Cal State Fresno where he continued to play football and graduated with an accounting degree. He also joined the Air Force Reserve Officer Training (AFROTC) and upon graduation was commissioned as a second lieutenant. His training took place at Webb AFB in Big Springs, TX. where it is said "it is so flat and clear down here you can see tomorrow coming." He trained on many planes and was assigned to fly a C141, a four engine high wing transport, to be based at McChord AFB, Tacoma, WA.



It was at an Air Force party on Valentine's day in 1970 that a lady entered the room and took his breath away. After Paul gathered his courage, he spoke with her. Her name was Diana and she later gave him her number, but nervously, he failed to write it down. To his surprise he remembered it the next day. Diana and Paul had their first date six months later and he said "the rest was history." They were married on Memorial



Day 2 years later in Orinda. Their lives were busy and took them to many places they called home: Connecticut, Washington DC and Cincinnati until one day when they bought a home back in Orinda, back on the same street he grew up on.

His service time consisted of many flights to Vietnam. His typical flight trip was a nonstop from Washington to Wake Island, then to the Philippines and ultimately Saigon, Cam Ranh or Danang. He once hauled 60,000 pounds of class A ammunition into Pleiku. Occasionally carrying wounded soldiers, Doctors and Nurses. Other stops included Japan, Thailand and more. Diana was a flight attendant for Seaboard World

Airways, also stationed at McCord AFB, so one could say they had a whirlwind romance that carried them over oceans and continents.

As a reservist Paul was recalled to active duty for 11 months during Desert Storm. During that time his Cargo plane carried Helicopters, air-to-air missiles, food and troops. His direction changed, flying first to Europe and then the middle east, mostly Saudi Arabia, once while the oil fields were burning, "Smelly to say the least." He once was able to actually fly around the world in one direction. Paul retired from the Air force a Lieutenant Colonel in 1991. He retired from Delta Air Lines in 2004.

Paul's wife, Diana was diagnosed with Younger-Onset Alzheimer's Disease (AD) at the age 56, and "to say we were devastated would be an understatement." Paul retired from Delta and cared for Diana until her death at 67 years of age. Paul became involved with the Alzhemiers association (ALZ) early, attending meetings in DC, to local efforts (Memory walks, fund and awareness raising events, etc.) and he remained involved after Diana's passing. 4 years later, he was asked



by ALZ to talk with a staff member about AD, a lady named Kay. Turns out that Kay was the Activities



Director at the facility where Diana resided. Paul and Kay eventually got together over a glass of wine to discuss AD. It became clear to them both, "that there was an attraction." Never was this expected, and yet so perfectly conceived.

Tennis became Paul's go-to activity after retirement and in between caring for his wife. He started in 2011 and has played over 500 matches, been to nationals 4x and still plays singles! Paul says "flying was just like going to play tennis – just plain fun. I was a lucky guy, and I think I still am."
