Up For A Challenge: Deanna Fong

As an effort to get to know our membership the Board has decided to start a new monthly column "Member Spotlight". We will be interviewing WCRC members and getting to know them. This article will help us find out how they got introduced to tennis, their background, any favorite memories, etc. We hope you enjoy this new commentary.

Parma Fong has always been up for a challenge and enjoys figuring out a way to get things done, and she had to utilize every bit of that growth mindset as she embarked on her tennis career at Heather Farm. When Deanna first came to check out the club in 2002 after not playing much tennis for the previous twenty years and having never played in a USTA league before, she met a lot of the local players and asked them how she could join a team at Heather Farm. Because of her lack of USTA experience, she was first asked to hit on court 1 so that they could assign her a visual rating, but she still found it nearly impossible to find a team to join. So, she decided to take matters into her own hands and organize her own team, but was unsure how to recruit players since she didn't yet know anyone. To help her recruit other 3.0 women to join her team, Tammie Snyder offered to run an ad in the WCRC newsletter announcing a date and time for an "open tryout" at Heather Farm for any 3.0 women interested in



joining the newly formed squad. Over a dozen people showed up and Deanna rostered them all. During the 2003 season, Deanna competed in a USTA league for the very first time while simultaneously captaining a team for the first time as well. With her second run at captaining, her team finished in 3rd place in the league



and ended up in playoffs!

One year for the WCRC Club Championships she entered in singles, women's doubles and mixed doubles. Not only did she win all three events she had three different outfits to match with her partners!

A Bay Area native, Deanna started playing tennis at age 10 and went on to play at Castro Valley High School. After high school she focused on other pursuits before she started playing again. Some friends invited her out to hit shortly before her initial venture out to Heather Farm.

They say that fortune favors the bold, and Deanna's bold step of starting her own team worked out in her favor. Two decades later she still counts several of the ladies from that first team as her closest friends, and some of those women moved up the USTA rankings step by step with Deanna, from their initial 3.0 team to 4.0, where Deanna currently plays, mainly in singles.

Over the course of the next two decades, Deanna has played on and captained several teams at Heather Farm, and coincidentally it was a tennis contact who helped Deanna land her current job as a business analyst with Kaiser Permanente, where she still works full time. One day, when Deanna was stopped at a stoplight in her car near the Walnut Creek Kaiser campus she saw someone she knew from Heather Farm crossing the crosswalk and wearing a Kaiser employee badge. She reached out to her new inside contact and landed a new job, and has been with Kaiser ever since. She's on the business side of the HMO, however, so don't ask her to diagnose your achy back or shoulder when you see her on the court.

Deanna's father and brother and sister all live in NorCal, but she said that she considers the Heather Farm community her second family, and she's glad she made the effort to start a USTA team when she first came to the club. Like any family, it can be work to develop and maintain relationships, but like every task she undertakes, Deanna was up for the challenge and is reaping the benefits through close





friendships and exciting tennis. You never know how one bold step can impact the rest of your life.
