Running the Shop:

Ciara Mendoza

As an effort to get to know our membership the Board has decided to have a monthly column "Member Spotlight". We will be interviewing WCRC members and getting to know them. If you play tennis at Heather Farm, you've almost certainly interacted with Ciara Mendoza. 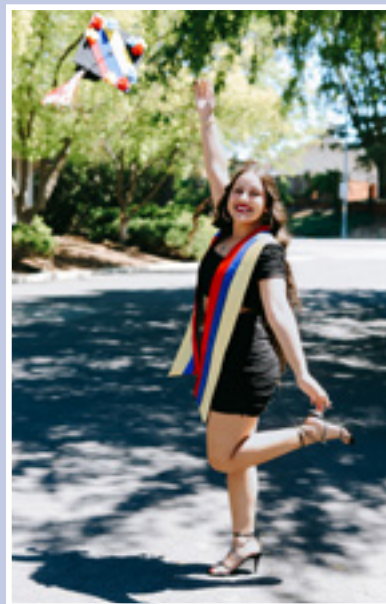

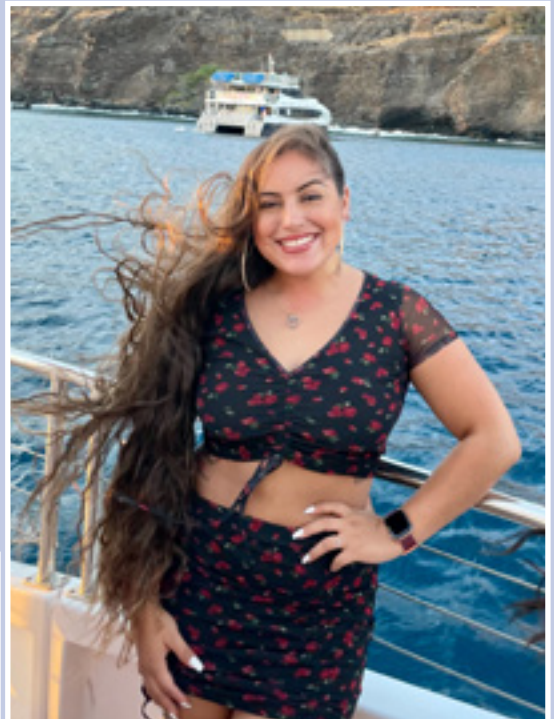

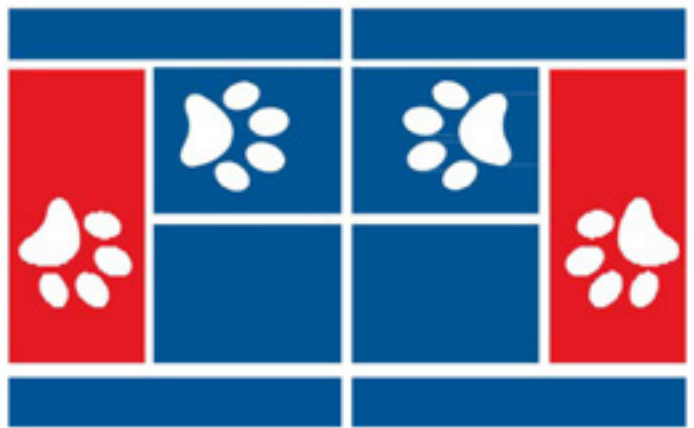
We have voiced our concern that we MUST have 3 contiguous courts for USTA. The City says they will find a solution for us if Stewart is deemed acceptable.

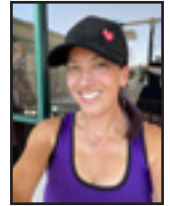
