# Spotlight

### **Keep Priorities in Order:**

### **Christian Joos**

As an effort to get to know our membership the Board has decided to have a monthly column "Member Spotlight". We will be interviewing WCRC members and getting to know them. This article will help us find out how they got introduced to tennis, their background, any favorite memories, etc. We hope you enjoy this commentary.

ike many of us, WCRC member Christian Joos honed his tennis game using a wooden racquet. As a child in San Jose, Christian spent summers riding his bike to the local swim/racquet club and playing there on the competitive ladder right around the time graphite racquets came out and provided a distinct competitive advantage over wood.

Christian's European blood runs deep as his mother's side of the family is 100% Norwegian while his father's family (and hence his family name) is Swiss.

After his childhood in San Jose Christian ended up working in the financial services sector, and spent some time working with Cantor Fitzgerald when that firm occupied the top two floors of the World Trade Center in New York before the towers were felled in the 9/11 terrorist attacks. Although he was working in the Japan office at the time of the attacks, several of Christian's colleagues and friends were in New York.



Like so many Bay Area natives, Christian eventually found his way back home and while living in Alamo he began playing tennis and golf at Stonebrae Country Club in Hayward and found



his way to Heather Farm specifically for the Calcutta tournament because he had played a Calcutta previously at Tahoe Donner tennis club and enjoyed the format. He joined WCRC's signature Calcutta tournament one year and Christian and his randomly assigned partner ended up reaching the finals, where they played before a large home court crowd. Christian and his partner ended up winning the tournament, Christian loved the electric atmosphere at the club, which he likens more to a country club than a public facility.

Years later Christian is still working in the financial services industry and still playing tennis regularly at Heather Farm, both USTA league and events like summer singles (which reminds him of the tennis ladder he competed in while growing up, (minus the wooden racquets).

Christian lives in San Ramon now but spends about half his time in Tahoe, and besides tennis he loves playing golf and skiing. And when he's at Heather Farm, Christian is often accompanied by the light in his life, his nine year old son PJ. PJ is an intellectually engaged young person and will often

do his homework while dad works on his tennis game. But Christian creates valuable family time out of these opportunities and usually takes long breaks from practice to help PJ with his homework or just to hang with his son, because they're only young once and Christian knows where he wants family to fit in his list of competing priorities. Right at the top of the list. �






