New This Month to www.wcrc.net - On Line Membership!

This month we've launched our new on-line membership area and we wanted to give you some tips on how to perform basic functions. We'll provide more detailed instructions about end of year renewals in the November and December newsletters but for now here's what you need to know:

LOGGING IN

To login to the new membership website go to www.wcrc.net and enter your username in the Username field and your password in the Password



field and click the Go button. You should receive your login information via email on October 8th - check your bulk email box if you have a SPAM blocker. If you need to have your password emailed to you, you can click the Forgot password link and enter your email address. For families with multiple members using the same email, you'll be prompted to contact our system administrator to receive your login information. If your email address has changed since you've become a member you'll have to email us at webmaster@wcrc.net to update your info.

CHANGING YOUR INFORMATION

To change your contact information, your username or your password, login to the system and click either

LOOKING UP SOMEONE ELSE'S INFORMATION

Our new site offers several ways to look up other members contact information listed under the Quick Reports section shown to the right. For a full listing of all members contact information, including addresses click the Member List (HTML) link under Quick Reports. To quickly find a member hold down the Ctrl key and hit the letter 'F'. This will bring up a dialog box in which you can type the member's name or part of their name to find their information.

ATTENTION ALL WCRC CAPTAINS: WCRC requires that all teams that play out of the Walnut Creek Tennis Center have a roster with either 100% WCRC membership or that any non-members pay a one-time single event fee. Use the above functionality prior to any captain's meeting to ensure that your players are all members of the WCRC. Choose the Member List (HTML) option as you'll need to ensure that any Single Event Fee members have paid the event fee for the current USTA League (this information will be in the address field for these types of members). At future captain's meetings, any team not complying with this standard will not be given courts for home matches.

REGISTERING FOR THE TURKEY TOURNAMENT

Registration for the Turkey Tournament is now online on our new membership website. To register follow these steps:

- ☐ Click the Turkey Tournament Sign-Up link under Event Registrations as seen below.

- Under Event Specific Information enter your NTRP Rating or if you are not rated, input the rating you think that you should play at, select your Gender and your format preference. Also, you must accept our waiver by clicking the checkbox by the agreement terms to sign up.

- Under Payment method, choose either Pay at the Event in which case you'll need to bring a check with you or choose the PayPal option in which case you'll need to be a PayPal member. Click Continue once you've selected an option.
- ☐ IMPORTANT: If you choose to pay at the event and then do not Cancel your registration prior to the deadline (11/15) and do not show up to the event, the registration fee will be added to any subsequent WCRC events that you attend.
