Looking for a Little Love and a Dropped Morsel

Ace The Wunderdog

Interview and article by Glenn McBee

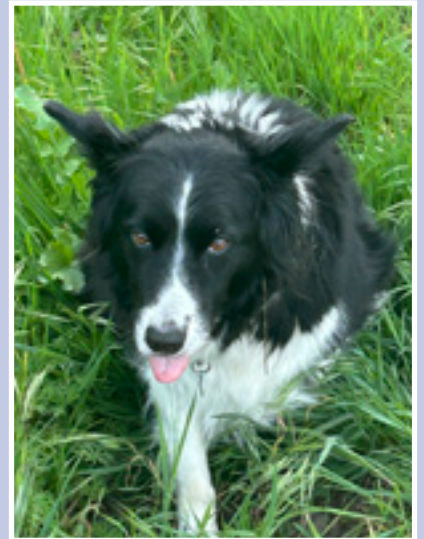
As an effort to get to know our membership the Board has decided to have a monthly column "Member Spotlight". We will be interviewing WCRC members and getting to know them. This article will help us find out how they got introduced to tennis, their background, any favorite memories, etc. We hope you enjoy this commentary.

Although not an officially registered WCRC member, this April Fool's edition member spotlight article features a ubiquitous presence at Heather Farm and the unofficial mascot of Walnut Creek Racquet Club, Ace the wunderdog. When interviewed for this article, Ace could only respond with "arf arf", "woof woof", and "grr..." so all information contained herein has been translated by Ace's human Glenn McBee, who can speak fluent canine and vouches for the accuracy of his translation.



Most regulars at the club already know Ace well because he's there almost as much as Glenn, who calls Ace his "foreshadow" who is often greeted by others before they even say hello to Glenn. Ace is a border collie that Glenn adopted from the Martinez animal shelter in 2015 and began bringing to the courts almost immediately since he spends so much time there himself. During the normalization process after Glenn adopted Ace and brought him home, Ace destroyed three Comcast TV remote controls when he was left home alone. Glenn wanted a smart dog and that's what he got, because Ace was showing some disdain for the frustrating cable behemoth by destroying the remotes !Perhaps part of the

abuse Ace had apparently suffered in the past included being forced to call Comcast customer service to try and resolve an issue. (although by chewing the remotes really Ace was chasing the scent of his missing owner's hand oils that remain on remotes and other handheld devices.)

Just a few days after adopting Ace, Glenn was driving home from tennis practice one day and suddenly realized that he had forgotten he even had a dog and had left Ace in the fenced front yard still wearing his "cone of shame" from being recently neutered. When he got home he found Ace in the attached garage but he bolted away as Glenn pulled up. When they lured Ace home by encouraging him to follow another neighborhood dog, that's when Glenn began training Ace in earnest, and because border collies are such an intelligent breed it took only a month to train Ace

completely to behave as an off-leash dog.

Since Glenn decided he wanted to change the name "Blaze" that Ace was identified by at the animal shelter, he decided to conduct a poll on Facebook and receive name suggestions from his friends (mostly friends through tennis) on that social media platform. "Ace" was the winning entry, although Glenn forgets who came up with the name on the Facebook poll. But those who know and love Glenn and have played tennis with him won't be surprised that the second and third most popularly suggested names were "long" and "out." Glenn went with Ace, which he felt most befitting of his new court companion.

Ever since Glenn began bringing Ace to the courts shortly after adopting him, Ace has been a steady presence at Heather Farm, and is a polite spectator, just sitting courtside and watching play without ever barking or chasing balls.



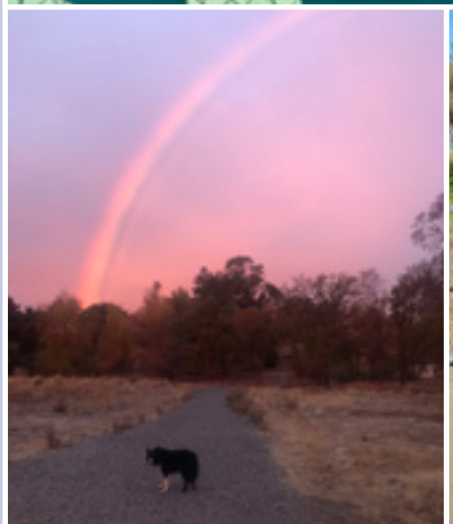
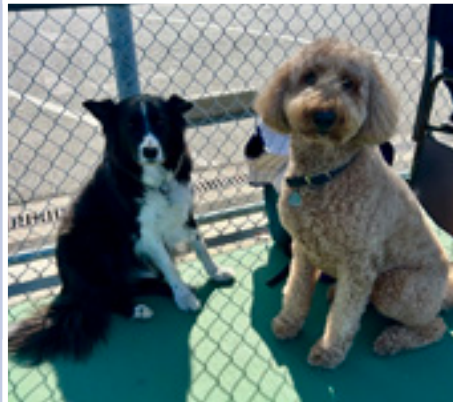
Ace continued...

Ace is loved and brightens everyone's day when they see him at the club, but his BFF is definitely Daisy, the Taiwanese Mountain Dog and co-mascot of the club whose human companions are WCRC members Chris Lau and Lena Larionova. Aside from hanging out together at the courts, Glenn and Ace often take walks together with Daisy through Heather Farm park.

When asked what he enjoys most about Heather Farm, Ace said

"woof woof woof arf arf arf" and "bow wow wow yippee yo yippee yay", the last phrase as a shout out to his favorite musical artist, Snoop Dogg.

But according to Glenn, what Ace loves most are the friendly people he meets and all the smiles and loving pats and petting he receives from the animal-loving tennis community. And it's just an added bonus when someone drops some food on the ground during one of the famously gourmet post-match spreads at the club. 🐾





National Champions!
