Saint Mary's Men's and Women's Teams Record Historic Finishes at Championships

The Saint Mary's College Gaels Men's and Women's squads completed their 2007 seasons with their best finishes in school history. During the season, each of the teams received national rankings, with the women finishing with a #60 ranking and the men's team just dropping out of the top 75 in the last few weeks or the season. The West Coast Conference Championships were held the week of April 16^th . The men's tournament was held in San Diego and the women's championship was in held in Malibu.

On the Men's side, Coach Michael Wayman's 5th seeded Gaels were victorious in their first match, defeating the #4 seed, Portland Pilots 4-1. In the second round, the Gaels dropped a tough second match to eventual champions and 9th ranked Pepperdine 4-0. In the 3rd place match, the Gaels defeated rival #2 seed Santa Clara Broncos 4-2 to equal the team's best run in conference tournament history.

For the women, the #2 seeded Gaels, coached by Lisa Alipaz, knocked off #7 Santa Clara 4-0 on day one of the tournament. On day two, they continued their run by defeating the #3 seed Loyola Marymount Lions, 4-1. The Lions were ranked #62 in the country. For the finals, the Gaels dropped their final match to #19 ranked Pepperdine by a score of 4-0, but the final score was not an indication of the battle on the court. The Gaels lost the doubles point on a tie breaker and in the singles matches, the Gaels #1 (Aude Lambert) ,#2 (Jessica Hoath) and #3 (Femke Strijbis) players had all won their first sets before the match was called. The women's squad has a shot at an at-large berth in the NCAA Championships, which will be announced on Tuesday, May 1st.
