Last month, Myrl Kan and Tammie Snyder's 6.5 Ladies Combo Team headed to Gold River Racquet Club for the Norcal Sectionals. They qualified by winning the Districts with (3)2-1 matches. It doesn't get much closer than that. On Friday, Millenium Vacaville, the #1 rated team in NorCal was the 1st match. As in Districts, all 3rd sets are decided by a 10 point super tiebreaker.

Vacaville barely pulled off the win with all 3 super tiebreakers going their way. Saturday followed with Silver Creek, the #2 team in NorCal. It was a hard fought match but the wrong Creek team won with 2 super tiebreakers. Sunday's opponent was Courtside Racquet Club. We took Courtside 2-1 to finish 3rd place in Norcal. One of the USTA officials told our team that 3rd out of 500 teams is not bad. If the 3 super tiebreakers had gone Walnut Creek's way, they would have won the Sectionals.

Our Ladies in Red & Black, played their hearts out throughout the weekend. From Araceli's overheads to Cheri's crosscourt returns to Tammie's serves to Myrl's angles to Marylyn's drops to Jennifer's down the lines to Nancy Chan's poaches and Nancy Foster's slice had all the teams respect the strength and depth that Walnut Creek had.

The Men's 6.5 Combo team came in third place at the sectional tournament at Gold River Tennis Club in Sacramento. We started play on the first day with a sweep of Vallejo winning 3-0, as Sterling Fairholm/ Tuan Nguyen won in a third set tiebreaker, Alan Rubino/ John Westphal won as their opponent had to retire due to an injury and Alan Chan/ Brian Costello won in a third set tiebreaker. The second day the same three doubles pairings were swept 0-3 by the eventual tournament winner (Sunnyvale). Two of the matches went to third set tiebreakers. Alan Chan/ Brian Costello had the fun of playing their grueling tiebreaker match on the stadium court. That put us at 3-3 and 2 games back of the leader entering after day two. We were tied with Hall Ranch and would play them going into the final day. Unfortunately the odds of winning the tournament at this stage were very much against us. On the final day we lost to Hall Ranch 1-2 as Siva Kolli/ John Westphal and Alan Rubino/ Brian Costello lost and Alan Chan/ Rafael Rovira won in a third set tiebreaker.

Over all this was a tremendous season for the team. One may feel disappointed at getting so close and not winning the championship. I agree but I take solace in being one of the best teams in our section, playing great tennis to get there and being good representatives of the WCRC.

This was a great group of guys who put forth a true team effort to get to sectionals. Each member can feel a sense of accomplishment for their contribution to the teams success.

All tournament participants must be current WCRC members.




